

Uniform Policy

Hunter Sports High School students wear their uniform with pride. All students are expected to wear full school uniform each day.

Parents/Carers are requested to ensure that students wear the Hunter Sports High School uniform with pride and to support the school's safety policy with regard to footwear.

Monday and Wednesday - Students are able to wear their whole school sports uniform all day or the all seasons uniform.

Tuesday, Thursday and Friday - Students are to wear their all seasons uniform consisting of white shirt and black shorts/pants or green skirt. All black shoes (leather shoes is a requirement in practical food technology and science labs) and optional tie.

PDHPE/PASS on a Tuesday, Thursday or Friday - Any students who has PASS or PDHPE must wear their all seasons uniform throughout the day and get changed into their sports uniform before and after the lesson. With the exception of period 1 when students can arrive in their PDHPE/PASS uniform and period 6 where students can go home in their PDHPE/PASS uniform.

GIRLS ALL SEASONS UNIFORM:

HSHS school skirt or black shorts (no shorter than mid-thigh), or black trousers/trackpants with a junior or senior white school shirt. White socks and black shoes. School black V-neck/hooded jumper or jacket.

BOYS ALL SEASONS UNIFORM:

HSHS black shorts or black trousers/trackpants and white school shirt. White socks and black shoes. School black V-neck or hooded jumper or school jacket.

SPORTS/PDHPE UNIFORM: UNISEX

Green sports shirt and black sports shorts (pictured below). The old yellow PDHPE/PASS shirt is still acceptable for students to wear. These will no longer be available for sale at Lowes.

SPORTS ACADEMY UNIFORM: UNISEX

It is compulsory for all Sports Academy students to wear full school uniform at all times. This includes full Sports Academy uniform at appropriate times. Sports Academy students must wear either dress shorts, pants or skirt and white shirt when representing the school. Please note that the school cap is compulsory uniform for all baseball, cricket, tennis and touch football squad members. Additional or replacement Sports Academy training uniforms are available at Lowes. The singlet is for basketball only and can only be worn during Sports Academy sessions.



WINTER UNIFORM:

Girls may wear black stockings under school skirts and only HSHS school leggings are allowed. Both girls and boys can wear the unisex school tracksuit, black V-neck jumper or hooded jumper.



SHOES:

The school expects that students wear safe black leather lace-up style shoes (including black sole) or a style which covers the top of the foot. Suede skate shoes are acceptable as long as they have a substantial leather tongue. NOTE: Covered leather shoes must be worn to all lessons involving practical work (Science, Food Technology, Industrial Arts). The Work, Health and Safety legislation requires fully enclosed footwear.

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- Shoes with mesh or fabric tongue
- Black or coloured flat 'ballet' styles
- Black fabric or canvas slip on shoes

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE:**

- Coloured t-shirts worn under the school shirt. If a shirt is worn under the school shirt, it must be white
- Multi-coloured jumpers
- Representative track pants or tops
- Tights under school shorts or skirts (black stockings only)
- Extremely short shorts
- Coloured caps or hats (no hats are to be worn indoors)

Note: Jewellery must be kept to a minimum. Large coloured or metal earrings are not part of the uniform.

The wearing of this uniform is supported by the school community and student representative body. The uniform policy is in line with Department of Education Work, Health and Safety guidelines.

For further clarification of the uniform requirements, please contact the relevant Year Advisor or Deputy Principal.

The community has accepted the wearing of school uniforms as part of the School Wellbeing and Discipline Policy.

The co-operation of all community members is required to encourage students to take pride in their appearance.

All students in uniform provides equity in that all students wear the same, which costs the same. Wearing school uniform promotes pride and dignity in oneself and earns community respect for the individual student and the school as a whole.

Any student who is genuinely unable to comply with the school uniform requirements due to financial reasons should contact the school. Arrangements will be made at the school to assist the student to comply with the dress code.
